This has been an exciting term for the Schools team. In October we visited two local schools, giving our presentation to all the Year 10 and 11 students at a Crawley school, and the whole of Year 10 at a Horsham school.

The Crawley school posted their thanks on social media, writing
"Today we welcomed the Oasis Crisis Pregnancy Centre into classrooms to deliver workshops to our Year 10 and 11 students. The charity provides interactive sessions to teach students about the development of the foetus and to consider the feelings and emotions that can arise in an unplanned pregnancy situation. Thank you for visiting us"



In January we will visit two more Horsham schools, talking to Year 10 at both schools. We are also looking ahead to March and April when we will give our presentations to Year 9 at two more schools, one in Horsham and one in Crawley. The work we do on pregnancy and abortion follows the Government Guidelines on Relationships and Sex Education and we are pleased to see how our presentations are linked into the curriculum, with many schools following up our visits in other lessons.

This is a very rewarding role: it is wonderful to have the opportunity to engage the students in discussions of the issues around unplanned pregnancy, considering difficult choices and their consequences, while also thinking about the life of the unborn child.

We are short of volunteers for our Schools team and would love to be able to deliver our services to more schools in our communities. If you would like to join our team we would love to have you! You don't have to be a presenter; most people join the team as an assistant, handing out sheets and running the PowerPoint. If you are interested in finding out more, do contact us and we can arrange for you to observe a schools session to see what is involved.

The Baby Clothing and Equipment Store continues to provide clothing and equipment for babies and children up to 24 months whose families are unable to afford to buy these items themselves.

At the beginning of this year, we began opening once a month on Monday mornings to serve the Happy Baby Group for refugee families, which operates at the Charis Centre. This has proved to be a huge success, so we have continued the practice. The sessions are invariably busy and it is very rewarding to help people who have left everything behind in search of a better life for their families, and who are currently in limbo, staying in hotels while they await the outcome of their applications to remain in this country.

Our regular weekly Thursday afternoon sessions have been quieter of late, and our prayer is that more people who need our services will come to us for help.

We are delighted to have welcomed three new volunteers to the team since our last newsletter. Sadly, we will be saying goodbye at the end of this year to a volunteer who has been a faithful member of the team for four years but has now decided to step down due to her many other commitments. We are grateful for all our volunteers and for their dedicated service, without which the Store would not be able to operate.

During the last few months, our 2023-24 accounts were independently examined by our Accountant and approved by the Oasis Trustees. We finished the financial year with a deficit of £1441. We are grateful for the continued and generous donations from local churches and supporters. If you would like to see a copy of the accounts, please do ask.

We are working hard to increase our income with fundraising and control our expenses. Two pieces of good news! Firstly we have recently received a very generous one-off gift that will enable us to stay in the black this financial year!
