1.18 Drugs, Alcohol & Medication (including prescribed medication)

Policy statement

We comply with health and safety regulations and the Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements of the EYFS in making our setting a no-smoking environment - both indoor and outdoor.

Procedures

Smoking:

- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our no-smoking policy. This includes E-cigarettes.

Alcohol/drugs

- If we have reason to believe any adult in the setting is under the influence of any alcohol/drugs they will be asked to leave the premises and disciplinary action taken.

Medication

- All staff medications must be stored in a locked cupboard. The Supervisor/Manager should be informed if the medication may affect the member of staff's ability to work effectively with the children. If the manager/Supervisor feels that a member of staff is a risk to themselves or the children due to the effect of any medication they will take appropriate action.
