



Prayer Diary February 2025

“With thankful hearts offer up your prayers and requests to God”

Philippians 4:6 [CEV]

Sat 1 st	Praise God for the team of volunteers who cook and talk with our guests each week for Saturday Kitchen and for the positive relationships we have built with the families who attend. Pray for things to go well today.
Sun 2 nd	Let us pray today for BRBK - for the children to have fun and enjoy the sessions. Above all, let us pray that each one will know how much God loves them and cares about them individually.
Mon 3 rd	Pray for those of our fellowship who have lost loved ones recently. Pray that they may experience God’s love and comfort as they come to terms with their loss and cope with the situation they find themselves in. Pray that they will experience the support and love of family and friends.
Tue 4 th	Pray for the Alpha Course session that will go ahead today. Pray that those who began the course will continue to come and that God will continue to work in their lives. Give thanks that several Horsham churches are offering Alpha courses this spring and pray that many will be blessed as a result.
Wed 5 th	Give thanks for the life of Elsie Phillips and pray that the special service this afternoon to remember her life will be an encouragement to her family and friends. Pray for all who will be taking part.
Thu 6 th	Give thanks for the group of ladies who meet regularly as Women’s Fellowship and for the encouragement they are to one another. Pray that God will especially bless their meeting this afternoon.
Fri 7 th	Let us pray for Cally and the Eagle Project team as they have recently started the new term of group sessions in the youth prisons of Sao Paulo - 5 groups every week, 4 with the boys and 1 with the girls. They are also continuing to accompany all the boys and girls who have been released. Praise God that in 2024 they had 93% success of young people working, studying and not returning to crime. Continue to pray for son Ben struggling with mental health issues.
Sat 8 th	Give thanks that over 100 members of Parliament attended a meeting in London recently to hear first hand reports of Christian persecution worldwide. The meeting was organised by Open Doors and is an annual event. Please pray that those who attended will have been educated and encouraged to speak up for the persecuted church.
Sun 9 th	Pray for those who will lead the service this morning and pray that God will enable us all to worship him from our hearts and hear what he might have to say to us through the words of the hymns, the reading of his word and the preaching.
Mon 10 th	Give thanks for our deacons and pray for them at this particularly challenging time. Pray that God will continue to guide them as they make decisions about the future leadership of our church and that he will give them all the strength and encouragement that they need. Pray especially for them as they meet this evening.
Tue 11 th	Give thanks for those running the Babies and Toddlers group and for those families who have come along so far. Pray that more will join and that God will use the relationships being built up to bring lasting blessing.
Wed 12 th	Pray that we will all take advantage of the opportunities we have for praying together with others and that God will guide our prayers as we consider the future ministry of the church. Pray for a spirit of unity and waiting upon God at the Zoom prayer meeting this evening.
Thu 13 th	Pray for those who will be cooking for and organising lunch club today and for those who will coming along to enjoy a meal in pleasant company. Pray that God will bless the conversations that will go on around the tables and the message to be given after the meal.
Fri 14 th	Pray that we may make the most of our outreach opportunities through radio and social media and that we can fill the roles required both before and behind the microphone. Pray that at least some of those who listen to the programmes will respond positively to the teaching.
Sat 15 th	Give thanks for the recent visit of Peter and Louise Lynch and pray for them as they return to Bangladesh to continue their ministry. Pray for wisdom for the interim government so that peace can be maintained and that those in mission training can safely live and work in the outreach areas.

Sun 16 th	Pray that the children in the crèche and their families will know God's love and goodness. Pray that these small babies and toddlers will be secure and happy in the crèche on a Sunday morning. Pray that the crèche team will be wise and loving. Pray too that God will provide necessary additional helpers.
Mon 17 th	Give thanks for those who provide coffee, cake and company on a Monday morning and pray for strength for them as they continue this important ministry. Pray for wisdom as they chat to those who come and seek to build relationships that will lead to spiritual blessing.
Tue 18 th	Pray that the family event being run today by Toy Library and Saturday Kitchen will attract a good number of families and that it will go well.
Wed 19 th	Pray for Dirga at Green Pastures Hospital in Nepal, teaching patients with leprosy disabilities how they can work safely in agriculture. Pray for workers teaching about treatment for the disease in western Nepal, where leprosy sufferers are ostracised.
Thu 20 th	Pray for the new groups and communities that Genesis Acaye has begun working with in Uganda – that they will work well to achieve the intended objectives. Give thanks for the growth of the church in the area and pray for the church leaders. Pray, too, that Genesis's family will keep well.
Fri 21 st	Give thanks to God that Bangladesh leprosy work will now be run by a board of trustees in Bangladesh. This is an exciting and profound moment as local people take ownership of local problems.
Sat 22 nd	Pray especially today for those of our fellowship who are unwell and for those who are recovering from surgery or undergoing treatment. Pray, too, for those caring for them and those waiting for operations or treatment.
Sun 23 rd	Give thanks for the group of young people who meet regularly on a Sunday afternoon and pray that they will be an encouragement to each other as they learn what it means to live as Christians. Pray for guidance for the leaders.
Mon 24 th	Give thanks for PMA and for those who help in any way to enable the group to enjoy a Pleasant Monday Afternoon. Pray for the gathering this afternoon to go well and that it will be an encouragement to all who will be there.
Tue 25 th	Give thanks for the number of different churches there are in our town and for the good relationships there are between them. Praise God for Horsham Churches Together and for the various events they plan during the year. Pray for guidance for the committee and for continuing good relationships.
Wed 26 th	Pray for the Church members' meeting this evening. Pray that enough people will attend for the meeting to be quorate and that God will guide in the discussion and in any decisions that will need to be taken.
Thu 27 th	Pray that there will be enough transport for all those wishing to take advantage of Craft Club to come. Give thanks for those who assist with the group at each session and pray that those who come will benefit from the session this afternoon.
