Sat 1 <sup>st</sup>	The media points us to the negatives in the world. Let us be thankful for and encouraged by the words
	of Jesus 'I have told you these things so that you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble,

Sun 2 <sup>nd</sup>	Pray for Ken Carter and David Wickersham as they lead the service this morning - that God will speak
	through them into the hearts of all who will be gathered. Give thanks for those who have recently
	started coming regularly and pray that they will continue to feel welcome.
