Sun 1 st	Pray for all involved in the service this morning. Pray that all who attend will be able to worship from their hearts and be challenged by the message. Pray for God to guide our prayers at the prayer gathering this evening.
Mon 2 nd	Pray for Cally and the Eagle Project team as they will be working in 5 boys' prisons and one girl's prison this term. This week they will have meetings with the staff at all the different prison units and then the following week begin the psychodrama sessions and individual counselling. They are following up the boys and girls that have been released and many of them are doing well.
Tue 3 rd	Pray for those who have suffered as a result of the flooding that has affected many parts of the country. Pray for a drier period of weather so that the waters can recede in time for farmers to sow their seeds.
Wed 4 th	Pray for Michael Hogg as he will be conducting Audrey Christie's funeral today and for comfort for all who mourn her passing.
Thu 5 th	Give thanks for the group of ladies who meet regularly every other Thursday for Women's Fellowship, and for the close relationships that have been formed over the years. Pray for the meeting this afternoon to be an encouragement to all who will attend.
Fri 6 th	Pray especially for the many Christians in Iran at this particularly difficult time in their country. Pray for those suffering persecution in various forms and for protection for those in danger.
Sat 7 th	Give thanks for those who help with Saturday Kitchen and that families continue to come. Pray for those who will be on duty today and for those who will enjoy the meal and the opportunity the children will have to play together. Pray for a real sense of God's presence.
Sun 8 th	Pray for the Space gathering planned for this evening, that a good number will come and that they will be blessed by the opportunity to worship and pray together. Pray for Anita as she leads the worship and that others will be willing to share.
Mon 9 th	Give thanks that there continues to be a good spirit of love and concern for each other within the group that meets fortnightly for a Pleasant Monday Afternoon and pray that this will continue. Pray today for Lynn Woroniecki as she will be speaking about the work of the Oasis Pregnancy Advice Service.
Tue 10 th	Let us pray for Tearfund's ongoing work in Afghanistan after the devastating earthquakes last September, which have long been out of the secular news. More than 2000 people died and many more thousands were injured. Tearfund's local partners are still reaching areas where roads were damaged and villages destroyed. Pray for the physical and emotional endurance for the relief teams, and protection against future tremors.
Wed 11 th	Pray for the AGM and Church Meeting that will be held this evening. Pray for a good number to attend and for guidance for all who will be taking part in presenting issues. Pray for guidance, too, for any decisions that need to be made.
Thu 12 th	Give thanks for the Lunch Club team willing to give time and energy in preparing and serving a meal to those who enjoy a meal in company with others. Pray for God to bless the conversations that will go on around the tables today and the message that will be given after the meal.
Fri 13 th	Pray for the After Alpha group that will be meeting this evening. Pray for those who will be leading and for the participants to learn lessons that will strengthen their faith and enable them to serve God.
Sat 14 th	Pray for Peter and Louise Lynch as they will soon be coming to the end of their time in Bangladesh with BMS. Pray for an encouraging last few months and for guidance as to what they should be involved in once they settle back in the UK. Give thanks for the new outreach areas and pray that many will respond to the message proclaimed.
Sun 15 th	Pray for the group of young people who meet at the home of Marion Richardson on a Sunday afternoon. Give thanks for those who have responded to the gospel and are seeking to live Christian lives and pray for God to continue to guide them.

Mon 16 th	Give thanks for the Coffee, Cake and Co. team who give time and energy to provide lonely people with the opportunity to enjoy the company of others every other week. Pray for those who will gather today, that they will have a sense of God's love and care for them.
Tue 17 th	Pray for those of our fellowship who are undergoing treatment for potentially serious conditions. Pray that they may know God's comfort and love at a difficult time. Pray that the treatment will bring healing.
Wed 18 th	Give thanks for all the national leprosy missions and their staff and supporters. Pray for faith, enthusiasm and cooperation as the journey toward zero leprosy continues. Pray that all will keep trusting in God's provision, timing and sovereign plan.
Thu 19 th	Give thanks for the opportunity that men have for coming together every other Thursday morning for coffee and fellowship with one another. Pray that it will continue to be blessing to many.
Fri 20 th	Give thanks for the team who pay for, buy and arrange the flowers for each Sunday and for those who distribute them afterwards to people who need a special token of God's love. Pray that others will be willing to help with this ministry.
Sat 21 st	Let us continue to pray concerning the future of BRBC- in particular that God will be preparing someone to take the leadership position and that he will guide us to that person.
Sun 22 nd	Give thanks for all who work behind the scenes to prepare for our worship services and the many other activities that go on in our building and pray that they will feel appreciated. Pray for others to take on roles where help is needed.
Mon 23 rd	Pray for Claire Bedford in her work at the Guinebor 2 Hospital in Chad. Pray for wisdom and strength in her demanding role as part of the senior management team. Pray that these relationships will deepen so that some will begin to take an interest in the reason for the existence of the church and come to faith.
