| Tue 17 th | Please pray for Arweis, a Somali Christian believer, whose father threatened to kill him when his son became a Christian. All but two members of his house church have been murdered, yet Arweis continues to serve Jesus in the Horn of Africa. |
| Wed 18 th | Praise God that the sessions in the various youth prisons in Sao Paolo, Brazil, are going well. Pray for the group from Milton Keynes going out today to visit Cally and the Eagle Project Team for a week. Pray that they will have a good time and that it will be a great encouragement to Cally and the whole team. Pray, too, for Cally to get relief from her painful back. |
| Thu 19 th | Give thanks for the Worship Group who lead us in worship each Sunday. Give thanks that they take time to practise each week and pray for them as they will be practising this evening. |
| Fri 20 th | After the widespread protests in Nepal last September, elections are planned for March but may be delayed. Pray for INF Nepal and other partners, that the work in hospitals and communities may be able to continue throughout the election process. Give thanks that assessment of work on projects to provide relief in isolated areas has been encouraging. |
| Sat 21 st | Give thanks for those who have undergone surgery recently that has been successful and for those who have been helped through receiving treatment. Pray for any facing a difficult diagnosis – that they will be able to get treatment that will help. |
| Sun 22 nd | Pray for all who will be involved in the service this morning and that all who attend will be blessed by the worship and challenged by the message. |
| Mon 23 rd | Pray for the people of Sudan where millions have been displaced as a result of the on-going civil war and where hunger is rising, and malnutrition has reached famine level in some regions. Pray for aid to reach these areas and for churches and aid agencies trying to bring help in very challenging situations. |
| Tue 24 th | Pray for energy and wisdom for Claire Bedford and the staff at Guinebor 2, Chad, as they work in an increasingly busy hospital. Pray that they will be able to find a way of installing the new solar inverters now that their American colleague who was in charge of technical matters has left the country because of the ongoing US visa situation. Pray that the US visa situation can soon be resolved. |
| Wed 25 th | Let us continue to pray about the situation in Ukraine. Pray for those who have lost family members and those who have been injured and give thanks for the church organisations in the country and in the bordering countries that are bringing help to those in need. Pray that a peace deal can soon be reached. |
| Thu 26 th | Give thanks for those who have taken on the responsibility of leading the Craft Club for those with visual impairment, which means devising and finding materials for a craft activity each session. Pray for them as they think of new ideas and pray that there will be enough helpers to assist those who need individual help. |
| Fri 27 th | Give thanks for the many groups who use our buildings during the week and for the relationships that are beginning to be built up between them and various church members. Pray that there will be those who will soon begin to show an interest in what the church stands for. |
| Sat 28 th | Pray for the Saturday Kitchen team this morning and for the families who will come. Pray that things will run smoothly and that God will bless the conversations that will take place while the children play and while they enjoy lunch. |
| Sun 29 th | Pray for those who will be preparing and serving the Fellowship Breakfast this morning and pray that a good number will come to enjoy the meal together. Pray that it may be an opportunity for each of us to get to know people we have not had the opportunity of getting to know formerly. Pray, too, for the Palm Sunday Service that will follow. |
